August 3<sup>rd</sup> - Archaeology Talk

An Ancient History of Ropley – 50,000BCE to 1800C Ropley may not be at the centre of the history of Hampshire, let alone England, but this sleepy village hides ancient gold treasure..... The talk will discuss Ropley's ancient history from Stone Age to the beginning of the Industrial Age seen through the finds and documents dug up by local historians and archaeologists. A landscape very different to ours now from the stone age rivers long since dried up, to Bronze age cemeteries and Brittonic and Roman farmsteads, to the beginning of Ropley – a Saxon settlement in a vast forest.
